TRAINING

- Maricela Jimenez, Executive Director, Guardianship Program of Dade County, Inc.
 - Mrs. Jimenez presented and educated the attendees on the Services provided by the Miami Dade Guardianship Program.
 - Currently, the program represents 1400 individuals per year. The 11th Judicial Circuit,
 GPDC handles more cases than all the other 19 Circuit courts combined.
 - In Dade County, the program has 27 public guardians. All guardians must pass a state exam/certification. There are 32 case managers and about 65 employees that provide support with administration.
 - Guardianship Process: Individuals must be assigned by a court-appointed process. They
 do not accept referrals. Three different physicians must evaluate and agree to delegate
 rights to the guardianship program.
 - Relationship with LTCOP and Guardianship program: If a long-term care resident has a guardian, please communicate any concern to the guardian. If there is a resident that may benefit from guardianship – refer to DCF-Adult Protective Services.
 - o Looking at strengthening relationship between agencies.
