TRAINING

- Carlos Gallostra, Registered Respiratory Therapist
- Carlos Gallostra holds a Doctorate degree in Health Care Administration. He is also a Registered Respiratory Therapist, and LPN, and is a licensed ALF Administrator. Mr. Gallostra has over sixty years of experience as a pulmonary care professional and three years as a Certified Ombudsman with the South Dade District.
- Mr. Gallostra spoke about the importance of having some knowledge about the oxygen concentrator device which is used for oxygen therapy in patients. This device concentrates the oxygen from a gas supply by selectively removing nitrogen to supply an oxygen-enriched product gas stream. Oxygen concentrators are used when a patient is prescribed supplemental oxygen due to low oxygen levels in the blood.
- Mr. Gallostra continued by saying that in his experience as an Ombudsman when visiting a
 Nursing Home, he had observed two oxygen concentrators with either expired tags or no tags at
 all. The Ombudsman met with the plant operations supervisor and provided education on the
 importance of oxygen purity and encouraged plant operations, not to depend solely on an outside
 company, but to personally review all concentrators in use by the facility.
